Biography of the Composer

Seymour Barab



Seymour Barab was born in Chicago, Illinois in 1921, and at age thirteen, began his professional career as a church organist. He later became a cellist in the school orchestra and after graduation performed with a number of orchestras across the United States.

After he served in the military in World War II, Barab took advantage of the G.I. Bill to spend a year in Paris, where he discovered his talents for musical composition. He produced over two hundred works in just one year. Barab loves musical theatre as well as opera.

This love gives him a unique ability to merge them both to create amusing children's operas.

Seymour Barab has been delighting audiences throughout his long career. He has composed operas, instrumental works and some of the most beloved and frequently performed children's operas all over the world.



And the youngsters are set free.


It is good to keep your promise.





The Pied Piper (a baritone) begins the show explaining who he is. He sings on a "bass clef" line.




The Mayor (a soprano) realizes at the end of the opera that it's time to make changes in the town and sings this song. She sings on a "treble clef" line.



Musical Terms

A clef is a symbol placed at the beginning of a staff (see above) to indicate the pitch of written notes. Different instruments and voices use different clefs. The most widely known are the "**treble clef**" and the "**bass clef**" ?: Other musical terms and symbols are in the music above. Can you identify them?





Rebus


A rebus is a tool which uses pictures to represent words or parts of words. Let's try one. What character is this?








